- Entry fees: Adults: non-members \$1.00, members 50c, Children Free.
- White Exhibitor Claim Tickets must be produced to claim exhibits & prizes.
- Most successful exhibitor: 1st = 3 points 2nd = 2 points 3rd = 1 point if awarded
- Pavilion opening hours: Friday 9.30am 5pm; Saturday 9am 8pm
